Short answers

21. Longitude varies with latitude (1 degree = 0-111 km) or

lat/long is sexagesimal (base 60) or

lat/long is N/S/E/W with some values digitally negative (left or below 0,0)

22. Red is the longest wavelength so it 'advances' and is visually prominent

Red is also associated with danger, fire, stop signs etc..

23. Topographic maps are general - show location of visual landscape features

Thematic maps highlight specific themes (layers) with individual locations not as important

24-25. Too many examples to cite here e.g.

Typography: too many upper case letters, ugly fonts, towns have first letter lower case, no italics for hydro features

Positioning: off horizontal/beyond vertical, overlapping lines, not centred etc.
